BYE LAWS

1. RULES AND ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME

- (i) The game shall be played in accordance with the rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
- (ii) **PRIORITY ON THE COURSE** – is determined by pace of play. Where a player is slow for some reason they must give way to players behind. Any match playing a whole round in entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than 1 clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.
- (iii) **LOST BALL** – When it is apparent that a ball will not easily be found, players searching should immediately wave through the players behind; they should not search for 5 minutes before doing so.
- (iv) The measures outlined above will make each golfer's experience more enjoyable.

2. DRESS CODE

Smart, casual golfing attire is acceptable in the Pavilion, on the course and on the driving range. Only golf shoes may be worn on the course. Gentlemen's shorts must be tailored and worn with calf-length socks.

The following are not permitted: Jeans, trainers, tracksuits, shell suits, T-shirts or shirts without collars.

Gentlemen are expected to wear jacket and tie in the Pavilion Restaurant for evening dinners and functions.

The above is for guidance and maybe varied at any time. Any person considered to be not complying by the Company with the Dress Code will not be served and will be asked to leave the premises.

3. TEE RESERVATIONS

All players must report to the golf Shop before commencing their game. Tee reservations can only be made in compliance with the Company's procedures as published from time to time. Tee reservations can only be made up to 6 days in advance. The names of players must be given and block bookings are not permitted.

4. COURSE COMBINATION

Course combination for competition will be decided by the Golf Secretary and for other games and matches by the Golf Shop Management.

5. DOGS

No dogs are allowed on the course or the Pavilion premises.

6. BILLS

Members and visitors must pay every expense they incur before they leave the Pavilion.

7. HANDICAPS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PLAYER

- (i) If a Member is a Member of more than one affiliated club, he/she must nominate one as his home club and notify that club and the others of his choice.
- (ii) Members may only have one handicap which shall be allotted and adjusted by his home club. The handicap shall apply elsewhere including other clubs of which the player is a member.
- (iii) When playing at an away club in a qualifying competition, a Member must inform the Golf Secretary if he achieves a net score which is lower than the SSS of the course.

8. ELIGIBILITY FOR PLAY

No person is allowed to play the course unless their subscription is paid up to date, or in the case of a visitor, the appropriate green fee has been paid. Members may introduce guests at a reduced green fee but no one person may be invited more than 6 times per annum. Only one guest may be introduced by each Member at any one time.

9. CHILDREN

Children under the age of 11 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times and are only permitted in the Pavilion between the hours of 7.30am and 6.00pm. The parent or guardian shall be responsible for the child's behaviour and conduct. No child under the age of 5 shall be permitted on the course, putting green or driving range. Any child whose behaviour or conduct is not deemed to be acceptable by the Company shall be asked to leave along with accompanying adult.

10. NOTICE BOARDS

Members must not alter or add to the notice boards without prior approval.

11. RESIGNATION OF MEMBERS

A single player has no standing and must give way to players behind. Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than 1 clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.
- (vii) LOST BALL – When it is apparent that a ball will not easily be found, players searching should immediately wave through the players behind; they should not search for 5 minutes before doing so.

6. DRESS CODE
