

## **Membership Information**

### **Welcome to Singing Hills Golf Course**

The process is relatively simple; we ask you to fill in an application form, sign the terms and conditions of membership and attend a short interview with the General Manager. Your application will be forwarded to the Directors of Singing Hills Golf Course Limited for their approval. Once this has been confirmed your membership will start from your agreed starting date.

We offer a full 7 day membership and our subscription year runs from November 1<sup>st</sup> Until October 31<sup>st</sup> the following year.

In order that you may obtain full benefit from your Membership, we list under various items of information we believe will be of assistance to you.

- **Tee Reservations**

We operate a full booking service for the use of the golf course when you may book your tee off time six days in advance, with the exception of medal competitions which can be booked 4 weeks in advance, or when an entry sheet is on the notice board. You may book by telephone or call into the Golf Shop in person. It is a requirement that whenever you play golf you do first of all register your arrival in the Golf Shop.

- **Guests**

A Member may sign in one guest per round at the current guest rate. Each guest may only obtain a reduced rate six times in any one year.

- **Driving range**

The driving range is open 7 days a week until dusk. Tokens are available from the Golf Shop.

- **Bar**

The bar is normally open 7 days a week from 11 a.m. – 9.30 p.m. Monday – Saturday and 12 noon – 9.30 p.m. on a Sunday during summer time. Times vary in the winter according to volume of usage.

- **Restaurant**

Catering is available 7 days per week with hot food available. On Sundays a Carvery is served between 12 noon and 2.00 p.m, for which you need to book.

- **Competitions**

All competition details are on the Notice Boards in the lobby entrance on the lower ground floor. Should you have any queries relating to competitions, please do not hesitate to contact the General Manager or Golf Shop staff.

The competition days are as follows:

The Senior Section play on Tuesdays.  
The Ladies play on Thursdays and Saturdays.  
The Mens Section play on Sundays.  
The Junior Section play on Sunday afternoon.

- **Etiquette**

All Members are requested when playing the golf course to ensure they avoid slow play. Please repair pitch marks and replace divots and at all times observe the rules of golf and respect your fellow golfers.

- **Dress**

Members and their guests shall at all times maintain an appropriate standard of dress.

Smart leisure and golfing attire will be permitted, although jacket and tie for gentlemen are generally required in the restaurant after 6.00 p.m. on any day. Under no circumstances shall jeans, T-shirts without collars, "Shell suits" or similar, or training shoes be permitted on the Course.

In the Pavilion smart casual clothing may be worn, including tailored shorts during the daytime (no T-shirts). Members and/or guests not complying with this requirement at the sole discretion of the Company shall be refused entry.

Spiked shoes may be worn in the Bar, Shop, Dressing Rooms and Entrance Hall areas only unless notices are posted to the contrary.

Spiked shoes and clothing soiled during playing in wet conditions should not be worn on the upper floor of the Pavilion.

The implementation of dress rules is at the discretion of Heads of Department and the Directors.

- **Smoking**

The restaurant is strictly non-smoking

- **Children**

Children under the age of 11 must be under adult supervision, and are only permitted in the Pavilion between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

Children with a recognised golfing handicap may play on the course, practice area, and putting green without supervision; otherwise they must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

No child under the age of 5 shall be permitted on the Course.

Any child whose behaviour or conduct is not deemed to be acceptable by the Company shall be asked to leave along with accompanying adult.

- **Valuables**
